## Play-Based Learning, Inquiry, and Modelled and Shared Instruction

**“Play is a means to early learning that capitalizes on children’s natural curiosity and exuberance.” —Ontario Full Day Early Learning Kindergarten Program 2010**

Children are naturally curious. They love to explore and manipulate in order to understand why and how things happen. The inquiry process has its unique place in the Kindergarten classroom.

Children learn effectively through *play* and *inquiry*, where they actively manipulate and explore materials, implement ideas, solve problems, and practice new skills. They learn when adults support them through *guided inquiry* that is playful, active, and of interest to them. They also learn through planned *teacher-modelling* of skills and strategies delivered in small-group, whole-class, or one-on-one settings where they can take new learning and use it in their inquiries and play.


