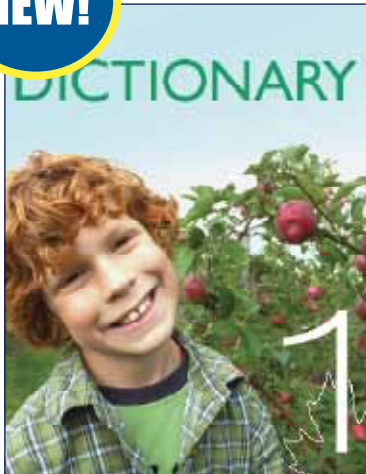

| <p>Pp</p> <p>paper noun (papers) 1 Paper is thin material on which you write and draw. Paper is also used for making things like books, posters, and crafts. 2 A paper is a newspaper.</p> <p>paragraph noun (paragraphs) A paragraph is one section in a piece of writing. A paragraph has one or more sentences that are about the same topic.</p> <p>parent noun (parents) Your parents are your mother and father.</p> <p>park noun (parks) A park is a large space with grass and trees where people can walk or play.</p> <p>parrot noun (parrots) A parrot is a bird with brightly coloured feathers and a large, curved beak. Parrots live in tropical forests. Does your parrot talk?</p> <p>part noun (parts) 1 One part of something is one bit of it. I read the first part of the story. 2 In Math, when you divide a whole object into equal parts, you divide it into equal pieces. There were four of us, so Giles divided the sandwich into four equal parts.</p> <p>partner noun (partners) Your partner is the person with whom you are doing something, such as working or dancing.</p> | <p>party noun (parties) A party is a gathering of people to have fun and celebrate something.</p> <p>peace noun 1 When there is peace, there is no war or fighting. 2 When there is peace, there is no noise.</p> <p>past noun The past is the time that is already gone. We remember what happened in the past, but it no longer exists.</p> <p>paste verb (pastes, pasting, pasted) 1 When you paste something, you stick it somewhere with glue. 2 To paste something into a file on a computer means to add it after you have taken it or copied it from another file.</p> <p>path noun (paths) A path is a narrow road or track. You can walk or ride along a path, but you cannot drive in a car on a path. <i>Chloe rode her bicycle along the path in the park.</i></p> <p>pattern noun (patterns) A pattern is the way something is arranged to make a design with repeated lines, shapes, colours, or numbers. The numbers 2, 5, 8, 11 are a number pattern. Every number is three more than the one before it.</p> <p>paw noun (paws) A paw is an animal's foot. Cats and dogs have paws.</p> <p>pay verb (pays, paying, paid) When you pay for something, you give someone money so that you can have the item.</p> <p>pedal noun (pedals) A pedal is a part of a machine, such as a bicycle, that you push with your foot.</p> <p>pen noun (pens) A pen is a tool that you hold in your hand and use to write or draw in ink.</p> <p>pencil noun (pencils) A pencil is a tool held in your hand for writing or drawing. It is a thin black or coloured stick covered in wood or plastic.</p> <p>penguin noun (penguins) A penguin is a black and white bird that usually lives in very cold places. Penguins cannot fly but are good swimmers. <i>Penguins live in the southern hemisphere.
